Class Specifications

1	Leadline	Open to a rider who is at least 2 years of age and riders that are not yet able to walk/trot independently. Handlers must be at least 14 years old. Stallions prohibited. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog both ways in the arena or on the trail. Saddle must fit the rider and rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups or irons for safety. An ASTM/SEI approved equestrian safety helmet must be worn by rider. A halter must be under the bridle with a minimum 6 foot lead line for the handler. The rider must show control of the horse. The handler is only for safety.
2	5-11 yrs	Open to riders 5-11 years. Only the rider is to be judged. To be judged on correct position of hands, seat, and legs of whichever discipline is exhibited.
3	12-16 yrs	Open to riders 12-16 years. Only the rider is to be judged. To be judged on correct position of hands, seat, and legs of whichever discipline is exhibited.
4	17 and under	Open to a riders 17 years old and under. Only the rider is to be judged. To be judged on correct position of hands, seat, and legs of whichever discipline is exhibited.
5	Adult	A rider 18 and over as of January 1, 2009.
6	Open	Open to all riders regardless of age and experience.
7	Green horse	Open to all horses who are either green or in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Only to be ridden by an experienced rider.
8	Western Equitation	Open to all western riders only regardless of age. All competitors are required to back in a straight line during the line up. Must be shown in western attire and tack.
